“Top Ten Office Medical Emergencies”

AM Session 9-11AM

Dr. Mark Fletcher will discuss the most frequently encountered medical emergencies and “urgencies” that typically occur in the dental office. This discussion will be audience-interactive utilizing “real-life” cases to reinforce the subject matter to include recognizing symptoms of each of the following occurrences: syncope, allergic reactions, angina, postural hypotension seizures, asthmatic attacks, hyperventilation, epinephrine reaction, insulin shock, cardiac arrest as well as, steps for treatment of office emergencies such as, initiating the EMS system, CPR, AED, and emergency drugs.

Mark C. Fletcher, D.M.D., M.D. is a Connecticut native, born and raised in Huntington. He is a graduate of Boston College (B.S., 1988), The University of Pennsylvania (D.M.D., 1992) and Jefferson Medical College (M.D., 1999, Magna Cum Laude). Dr. Fletcher is a Board Certified Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeon (American Board of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery). He is a Fellow in the American Dental Society of Anesthesiology and a Diplomate of the National Dental Board of Anesthesia. Dr. Fletcher serves as a Clinical Instructor in the Department of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery at The University of Connecticut School of Dental Medicine. He also serves as the Educational Coordinator for the UCONN oral and maxillofacial surgery residency at Hartford Hospital. Dr. Fletcher’s professional interests span both hospital-based, and office-based surgical procedures including reconstructive and corrective jaw surgery, oral and maxillofacial pathology, and bone grafting and dental implant reconstruction. He is an active member of the Maxillofacial Trauma Team at Hartford Hospital and Connecticut Children’s Medical Center. He is a member of numerous professional organizations including the American Dental Association, the American Medical Association, and the American Association of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons. Dr. Fletcher and his wife Jennifer reside in West Simsbury, with their son, Jack.



iTero PM Hands-On Session 1:15-3PM OR 3:00-4:15PM



The iTero system utilizes an intra-oral scanner to capture the 3-D geometry of patient’s teeth with enhanced visualization and real-time analytical tools. The iTero system eliminates conventional impressions, replacing it with a highly-detailed digital scan. Utilizing the digital model, a physical model and removable dies are milled and sent to the lab. The result includes precise fitting restorations, reduced chair-time, and increased patient satisfaction. This lecture will also feature a hands-on experience, allowing you to see how this amazing technology works!
